Dear Friends,

Jesus reminds the brothers, James and John in today's gospel that they do not realise what they are asking for when they ask Jesus to do them a favour. "Allow us to sit one at your right hand and the other at your left in your glory." They had a good feeling about Jesus and his project. They had seen plenty of evidence of his popularity because of his miracles and they remembered the words spoken in last week's gospel that those who have left parents, family, even land for the sake of the gospel and for his sake "who will not be repaid a hundred times over..." Surely this is a good bet? They saw Jesus the successful person who did much for others and NOT the Jesus who was about to come into conflict with authority and ultimately pay for that with his life. Jesus saw himself as a servant, beautifully expressed in the chorus to 'The Servant King':

*"This is our God, the Servant King,  
He calls us now to follow Him,  
To bring our lives as a daily offering  
of worship to the Servant King."*

The church too is viewed by many clergy in this same way as James and John viewed Jesus and they see themselves as the chosen ones. It's called "CLERICALISM" and it's not good.

This feeds into the event that Pope Francis launched in Rome last Sunday at St Peter's. The text of his homily you will find on the Vatican website: <https://www.vatican.va/content/vatican/en.html> and then select 'homilies.' It introduces us to another model of understanding the church based on three words: 1) Encounter; meeting Jesus in a variety of ways and often in prayer, reading and dwelling on the fact that HE IS FULLY ATTENTIVE TO US at all times. 2) Listen; he wants to hear from us and we need to hear from him. 3) Discern; figure out what is going on in our lives and bring it to him to discuss and listen back. This is the area that James and John fell down on, they did not hear Jesus say, "not without persecution", instead they only heard the bit about being rewarded 100fold. No wonder they jumped at leadership roles!

Pope Francis wishes the faithful to enter a period of reflection, prayer and discussion that will go on for nearly two years and culminate in the prayerful collective wisdom to formulate a type of leadership in the church which he is now calling 'SYNODALITY.' It's up to individuals, groups, parishes, diocese etc. to support this initiative. I am personally very hopeful that we (the people) will involve ourselves in this venture. (More later).
