Dear Friends,

We come to the last Sunday of the Church's year. For this cycle of readings here is where the story ends with the words of Jesus. The word "KING" could hardly be more out of place than in this context. In reply to Pilate's question asking Jesus, "Are you king of the Jews?", he replied, "My kingdom is not of this world, if it were of the world my servants would have been fighting, that I might not be delivered to the Jews" (John 18:36). He is NOT a king in the worldly understanding of power, rule, and dominion. The leadership of Jesus Christ is best summed up by the last words of today's Gospel. When one of those beside Jesus on a cross asked Him to "Remember me when you come into Your kingdom", the reply was all he could wish for, "Today you will be with me in paradise."

If in our prayers we are mindful of those words; "Jesus, Remember me", we will also receive the consoling verdict.
