There is an element of hectic activity that takes place in the Churches calendar at this time of year, eg Holy Communion, Confirmation, and Reception into the Church. The setting in the readings is more sober as you will hear in today's readings. The jump or movement from the message of the Risen Jesus to the world of today can be expressed in many ways.

I came across a model which we give little emphasis to. The subject, Jesus has died, He is risen and we believe will come again seen through the eyes of a child. It is modelled on the commandments.

- 1) Thank God for each day you wake up. So pray.
- 2) Be thoughtful and kind in what you do and say.
- 3) Share your time and gifts cheerfully.
- 4) Help all you meet without being asked.
- 5) Take care of all creation, people, animals & plants.
- 6) Be true to what is really important.
- 7) Respect other people's ways as if they were your own.

- 9) Be happy for your friends and neighbours when good things happen to them.
- 10) Show God your love by loving others.
