New Parish

We are now very close to OLQH becoming part of a new parish, provisionally called the 'Woking and Surrey Heath parish.' This will be confirmed following a diocesan meeting on 29th October and we anticipate that the official start of the new parish will be the First Sunday in Advent. Between these two dates, there will be update meetings with the churches that will form the new parish. There will be one leadership team for the new parish, but each of the churches will retain a local pastoral council. Where possible, we will coordinate or have joint activities. For example, the Advent and Lent small group meetings. Even though the new parish will officially exist from the end of November, there will be a huge amount of work still to come to fully establish and get it running. We are therefore asking all our parishioners to give some thought as to any concerns or questions that you may have, as these can be addressed in the update meeting planned for November (date to be confirmed).
