### Dear Friends,

Today we will celebrate Remembrance Sunday in honour of the many who gave their lives in the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> World Wars. A minute's silence will be observed to begin each mass. It is good for all to remember the sacrifices made by prior generations to enable us to live in freedom and side by side with people from many countries on the face of the earth. Once we lose the identity of the nation we lose our values and our soul. At this time in history, it is good to remember the sacrifices made by generations before our time.

This year, it coincides with the Consecration of the Basilica of St John Lateran in Rome. This is called the mother church of all Catholic churches throughout the world.
