We are now in the holy season of Easter which lasts for seven weeks. Today's Gospel gives us a clear picture of the confusion experienced by the disciples after the traumatic events of Holy Week, the last supper, the trial of Jesus, the way of the cross, the crucifixion and death and now we hear that some women went to the tomb and found it empty. I mention "women" here specifically as one of our very well-known bishops said recently that it was "men" who found the tomb empty. Maybe only a slip of the tongue or could it be that he did not know? Then the men came on the scene and heard their story. They did not recognise Jesus until the breaking of bread. Are our eyes open at the breaking of bread each time we go to mass? This may apply to all of us: we see what we expect to see and hear what we expect to hear in everyday life.
