Today, we celebrate God's own feast, expressed as THE HOLY TRINITY, i.e. Father, Son and Holy Spirit. Humanity could have lived thousands of years on planet earth and never come to this true identity of God. It is revealed in scripture to us and that is the only reason we know.
